**Arrival: 4:00 AM**

Lithuania's third largest city, Klaipeda has been in and out of the hands of the Russians, Swedes and Germans. Head to the pristine Baltic waters lapping at the broad sands of Smiltyn? Beach. Or duck into the Clock Museum or Castle Museum.

## **Day 5: Day 5: Riga, Latvia**

**Arrival: 9:30 AM | Departure: 5:30 PM**

As the largest city in the Baltic and the capital of Latvia, Riga offers something for everyone. From its fanciful cobblestone streets and Art Nouveau architecture to dozens of museums and a picturesque white-sand beach in nearby Jūrmala, there's much to experience in this vibrant cosmopolitan city. Come explore what has been called the "Paris of the Baltics."

## **Day 6: Day 6: Stockholm (Nynashamn), Sweden**
